Nevertheless, you can enter such settings, so that, entering program, mobile phone system will not ask you anything additionally. All actions will take place automatically.

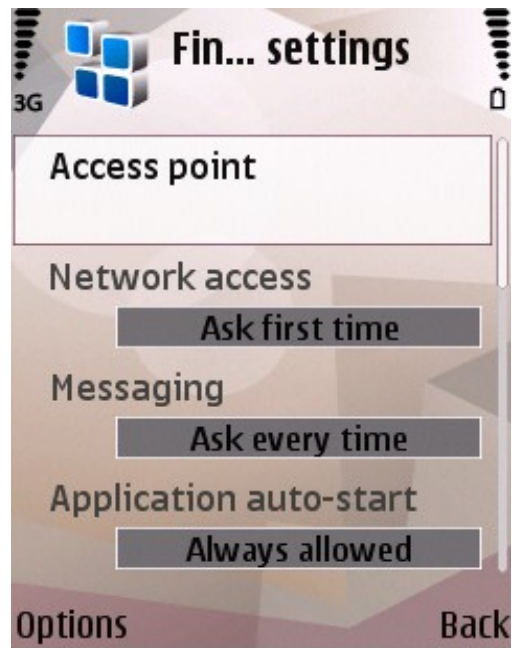
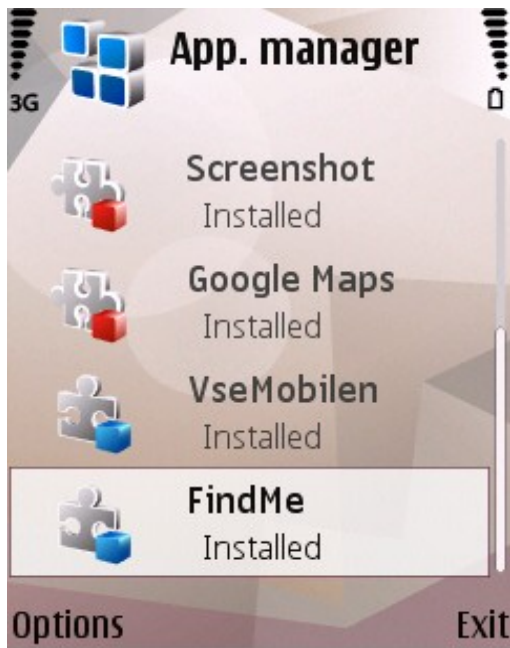
Such example of settings is shown for Nokia N95. Some distinctions are possible on other mobile phone models.

Choose Dispatcher application.

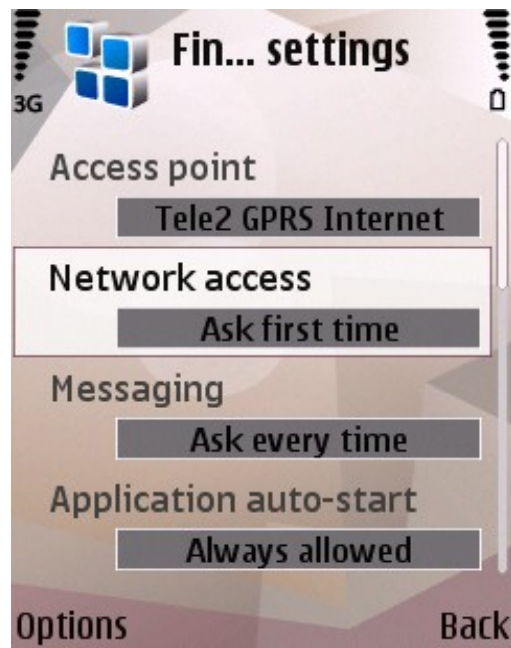
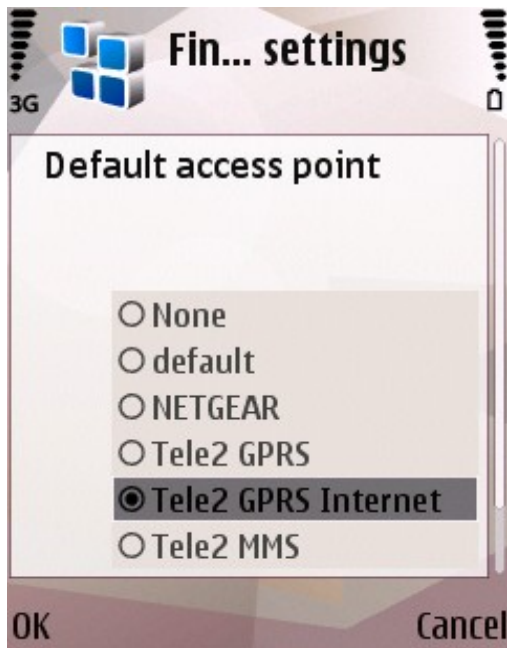


Find FindMe program in application list.
Open FindMe preferences.

In preference list, specify changes, shown on the picture.

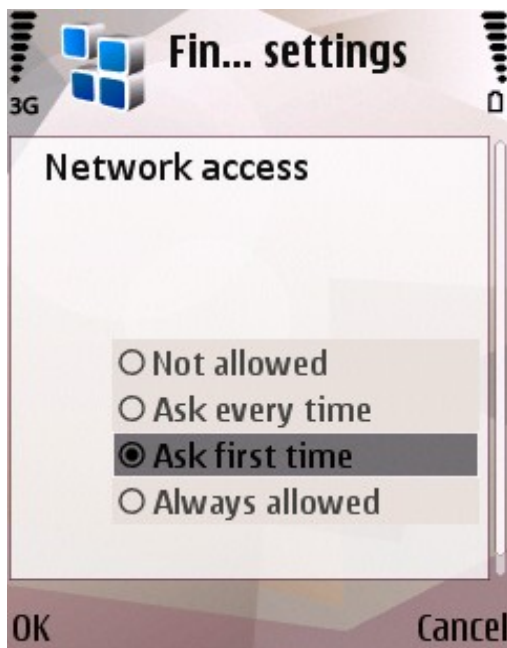
We recommend you to always set "Permitted" mode, so that system does not ask you on each action

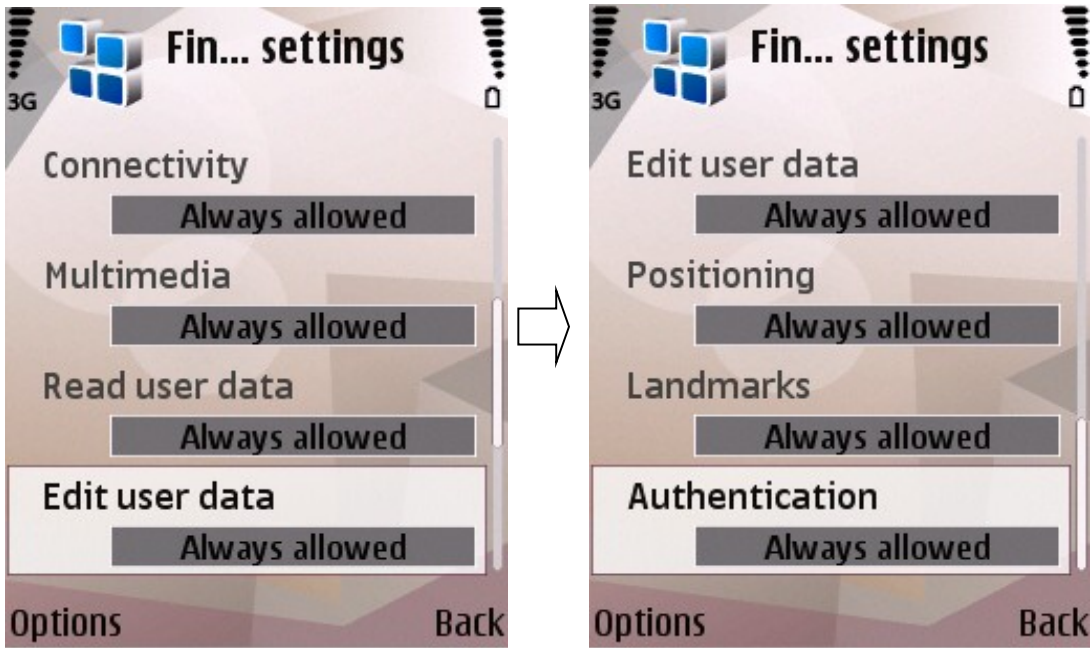
We recommend you to leave "One request" in access point settings "Access to the network" only.



Open Access point preference and change to the one you usually use to access Internet.

Now continue entering preference changes, as shown in pictures.
